(One appraisal item per half hour) Appraisals will be given for antique and contemporary (including art) quilts of all sizes, and quilted textiles (including but not limited to garments, wall hangings, bed size quilts, and quilt tops). No afghans. Coverlets are OK.

Your quilt/garment can be appraised either hung in the show or as a carry in. I will schedule appraisal appointments *for guild members only* from Feb-April 14<sup>th</sup>, and will open appraisal appointment requests to the general public starting April 15<sup>th</sup>. Please spread the word to the community about the quilt appraisals. Encourage your non-member friends to have their quilt(s) appraised, either old or new.
