
Mystery Quilt

Mystery 2011 Step #3

Join the 2-5/8" Dark half-square triangles to the remaining Step-1 half-square triangle unit to make 36 units that look like this.

Be careful not to confuse the pinned-together corners you cut from the Dark rectangles with the 2-5/8" Dark half-square triangles you should be using here!

Press seams toward the Dark Triangles.







Raffle Quilt

BOM # 11 one more to go

Cutting

Background Fabric

Cut (8) 3" squares. Cut (4) 2½" x 6½" rectangles. Cut (8) 2½" squares.

Green Fabric


Cut (4) 3" squares. Cut (2) 2¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" rectangles. Cut (2) 2¹/₂" squares. Cut (2) 1" x 4" stems.

Burgundy Fabric

Cut (4) 3" squares. Cut (2) 2¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" rectangles. Cut (3) 2¹/₂" squares. Cut (2) 1" x 4" stems.

Half-square Triangle Units


- Make four pairs of 3" background/ green squares and four pairs of 3" background/burgundy squares, right sides together. Mark a diagonal line and sew a scant ¼" on both sides of the marked line.
- Cut on marked line, press toward darker fabric, and square up the units to 2¹/₂".



Important! When squaring up, make sure the diagonal seam hits both corners



Assemble block as illustrated below.




Prepare Stems


Fold and press the long raw edges toward the center of the wrong side (approx. ½" wide finished strip). Center the stems on four 2½" background squares and topstitch in place with matching thread, clear thread, or appliqué by hand. Trim the stems to the shape of the background squares

Assemble block

Assemble triangle rows exactly as illustrated. Be careful of triangle direction. Press seams to one side, or, press open. Make two of each set.

Assemble leaves: make two of each.




