The mission statement of QOV, "To honor, thank, and comfort those touched by war", is a simple statement with powerful results. We take bits and pieces of fabric, and create a tangible thing of beauty. 15 of your QOV quilts were awarded in June. Each recipient received not only a quilt, but, more importantly, a symbol of the outpouring of love and caring from each of us.

Thank you so much, Carol Coyle (Spools and Jewels, Cascade IA), for your very generous donation of patriotic fabric. It is much appreciated and will be used in many future Quilts of Valor. The first project planned with your fabric will be a "4 Hour Carpenter's Star" QOV. I got the pattern off the internet and will have fabric ready for the July sew-in. We'll test the "4 hour" theory, that's for sure!

A big thank you also goes out to the Back Stitch Quilt Shop, Elkader IA. They sponsored a block drive, using the 2014 QOV official block, "Hearth and Home". (Karen & I both have the pattern available.) I'll be heading up there early this month to accept their blocks. Thanks also, Sharon Harmon and Sharon Klocker, for the Hearth and Home blocks you gave me at last month's guild meeting. I already plan to use these blocks as framing for some patriotic panels.

The first QOV group ceremony in Dubuque this year will be held Aug. 3rd and 14 Veterans will receive a much-deserved Quilt of Valor. The second group ceremony will be in September where another 14 veterans will be honored.

In October, Carnegie Stout Library (Dubuque) would like Quilts of Valor hanging from the rotunda. This will culminate Nov. 2nd, with a formal awards ceremony of 20 or so Veterans receiving their Quilts of Valor. Hopefully these ceremonies, along with individual ones along the way, will take care of my backlog of 60.

There are not enough ways to express my thanks to you, my guild friends, for your support and help. I think the numbers mentioned at last month's meeting may have been a bit daunting, but you are not alone in providing QOVs to fill the requests. Quilters in Sherrill IA are providing 10 quilts, as well as the Williamsburg Quilt Guild who are sending me 8 QOVs in August. I keep praying, and God provides.
