



## 2016 Quilt Show Exhibit Categories and Information

### **Definitions:**

**Kit:** Any pattern with fabric included, or one in which someone else chooses the fabric, including Block of the Month quilts. Kit/pattern information should be indicated on registration form.

**Pattern:** Any published pattern or design, purchased or not, including BOMs, in which you choose the fabric. Pattern information should be indicated on registration form.

**Traditional:** A design based on traditional blocks, such as Churn Dash or Ohio Star, and for which you chose the fabric and layout without using a pattern.

**Original:** The design of the quilt, including layout and color/fabric choices, is entirely the maker's own work, using NO existing pattern or design, purchased or not. Changing one or two elements of an existing design is NOT sufficient to make it original.

**First Entry:** Someone who has never entered a Cable Car Quilt Show before.

**Division measurement is the perimeter of the quilt:** [(Length + Width) x 2] OR simply add all sides together. All classes may be any technique. If the quilt is mixed machine and hand quilting, the PREDOMINANT form of quilting determines category entered. Decision is the quiltmaker's.

### **BED COVERING DIVISIONS: Designed to be used on a bed or other piece of furniture**

#### **Division 1: King/Queen Bed Covering—350" or more perimeter**

Class A: Hand Quilted by Maker

Class B: Machine Quilted by Maker

Class C: Duo Quilt; Top made by and/or quilted by two persons, hand or machine

Class D: Group Quilt; top made by and/or quilted by three or more persons, hand or machine

#### **Division 2: Double/Twin Bed Covering—280" up to 350" perimeter**

Class A: Hand Quilted by Maker

Class B: Machine Quilted by Maker

Class C: Duo Quilt; top made by and/or quilted by two persons, hand or machine

Class D: Group Quilt; top made by and/or quilted by three or more persons, hand or machine

#### **Division 3: Small Bed Covering—up to 280" perimeter**

Class A: Hand Quilted by Maker

Class B: Machine Quilted by Maker

Class C: Duo Quilt; top made by and/or quilted by two persons, hand or machine

#### **Division 4: Juvenile Quilts—Juvenile Theme or Made for a child**

Class A: Crib—any technique, up to 210" perimeter

Class B: Bed—any technique; over 210" perimeter

Class C: Duo Quilt; top made by and/or quilted by two persons, hand or machine

**WALL HANGING DIVISIONS: Designed to hang as a piece of art or decoration, rather than used as a bedcovering; with or without embellishments.** Quilt DOES NOT have to be an "art" quilt. Consider having your silent auction entry judged.

**Division 5: Small Wallhanging: up to 100" perimeter**

Class A: Hand Quilted

Class B: Machine Quilted

**Division 6: Medium Wall Hanging: 101" to 200" perimeter**

Class A: Hand Quilted

Class B: Machine Quilted

Class C: Duo Quilt; top made by and/or quilted by two persons, hand or machine

**Division 7: Large Wall Hanging: over 200" perimeter**

Class A: Hand Quilted

Class B: Machine Quilted

Class C: Duo Quilt; top made by and/or quilted by two persons, hand or machine

**Division 8: Other Quilted Items – table runners, purses, clothing, etc.**

Class A: Hand Quilted

Class B: Machine Quilted

**Division 9: Non-traditional or Art quilt**

**Original Designs ONLY – all work, including quilting, done by the maker**

Class A: Up to 100" perimeter or circumference

Class B: 101" – 200" perimeter/circumference

Class C: 200" or over

**Division 10: Junior entries, age 18 or younger. Work must be done by the entrant. Maximum size is 60" x 60".**

**Division 11: Quilts entered for Exhibit Only. Size must be stated on registration form.** Quilts for Exhibit Only will be exhibited as space permits, with preference given to members who have not entered other quilts for judging.

**Entries are limited to 3 per person per category. Entries in DUO are limited to 3 per duo but each person in the duo may enter with other people.**
